KICKSTART PILOT PROGRAM

Workshop 1 - Training for managers and mentors who will be involved with graduates (half day for managers, with graduates joining for the last hour)

- Leadership, supervisory skills, coaching and mentoring, self-directed orientation process, workplace project, learning plan and networking
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Graduates complete self-directed orientation over next 2-3 weeks

- Review of key business policies, discussing them with their team and manager, interviewing key people in the business about their role and what behaviours are most valued in the workplace
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Workshop 2 - Professional skills for graduates

- Personal brand such as dress codes, body language, building rapport and how to build an effective relationship with their manager and with mentors
 - Teamwork & business etiquette
 - Project management including budgeting, stakeholder engagement, and risk management, developing a project plan for their workplace project
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Workshop 3 - Making an impact for graduates

- Business communication & writing, customer service, how to contribute effectively at meetings
 - Understanding personal style & how to work with a diverse range of people
 - Time management and setting priorities, linking their behaviour and decisions with the values & vision their organisation
 - Giving and receiving feedback, including how to seek feedback from managers and peers
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Workshop 4 - Commercial/Business skills for graduates

- Client & business development skills including influencing & negotiation skills, persuasive writing for business cases & proposals, critical thinking, analytical skills, decision-making, innovation & creative problem solving, presentation skills
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Workshop 5 - Personal mastery for graduates

- Emotional intelligence, self-awareness & leadership, people management, learning to influence the performance of teams and organisations
 - Questioning skills & how to manage ambiguity, conflict resolution, resilience/stress management
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Workshop 6 - Project presentation & end 1st year celebration

- Graduates present their workplace project, including how they have added value to the business by saving time/money and/or growing the business

BENEFITS

- By the end of the process, graduates will know what 'good' looks like, so they don't have to learn by trial & error, and you don't have to spend as much time in performance management.
- Regular meetings with a workplace mentor and/or line manager, after each workshop, focusing on key learnings the graduate will apply back in the business.
- Professional/technical training, including working towards any professional accreditations required by your industry. This is included in the graduate's individual learning plan, which is developed at the start of the program.
- Provision of E-learning & online support.
